TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

If you are interested in transportation services, please visit your senior center for more information.

PRT BUS, INCLINE & T-RIDES

Free transportation for citizens over the age of 65. You must have a Medicare card, PRT Free Bus Pass, or PRT Connect Card.

ACCESS 65 PLUS

Visit a senior center or call **412.562.5353** to sign up. You can also call **800.654.5984** to request an application. There are no limits on location (within 1.5 miles of Allegheny County or usage. Riders pay fare).

OLDER PERSONS TRANSPORTATION (OPT)

Visit a senior center or call **412.350.5460** to sign up. Persons between the age of 60 - 64 need a prior authorization from the Area Agency on Aging. Limits
