MEET CONTROLLER O'CONNOR

Corey O'Connor was sworn in as Allegheny County Controller on July 10, 2022 after being nominated for the office by Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf and unanimously approved by the Pennsylvania State Senate.



Previously, Corey represented Pittsburgh City Council District 5 from 2012 until assuming the Office of Controller. Among his accomplishments on City Council:

- **Introduced a bill requiring the Tax Abatement and Tax Increment Financing Programs to be audited annually.**
- **Supported an amendment to the City budget to strengthen financial support for small businesses and affordable housing during the pandemic.**
- **Oversaw the creation of Pittsburgh's second largest park by co-chairing the Hays Woods Task Force.**
- **Supported the inclusion of storm water mitigation, flooding prevention, and other environmental disaster prevention in City budgets.**
- **As a member of ALCOSAN's Board, facilitated customer assistance program.**
- **Enhanced critical infrastructure transparency and reporting.**
- **Developed Pittsburgh's 'Paid Sick Leave' law.**
- **Improved accountability and prevented malpractice throughout the construction industry with the Joint Task Force on Construction Industry Fraud.**
- **Provided incentives to small, local businesses that increased their minimum wage.**

In his early career, O'Connor served as a Community Development Representative for Congressman Mike Doyle.

In his personal time, he has coached Central Catholic High School's varsity golf team to multiple State Team Championships and WPIAL Team Championships since graduating from the school. In 2006, he earned a Bachelor's Degree from Duquesne University.

Corey is the youngest of Pittsburgh's late Mayor Bob O'Connor and Judy O'Connor's three children. He lives in Swisshelm Park with his wife, Katie, and their children, Molly & Emmett.

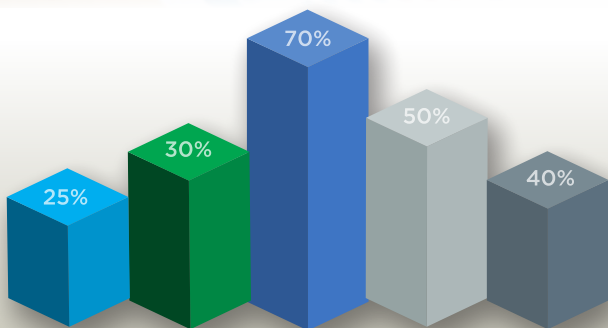
