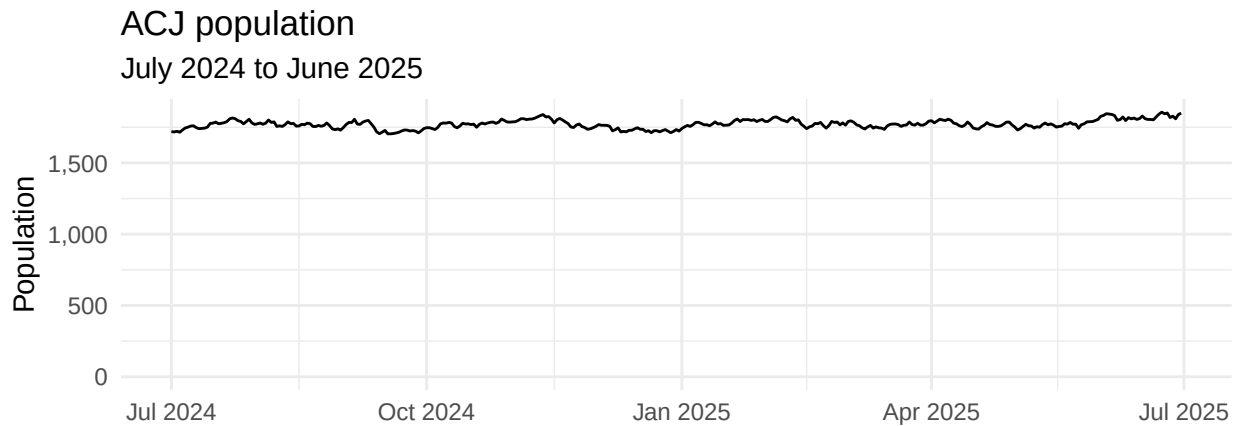

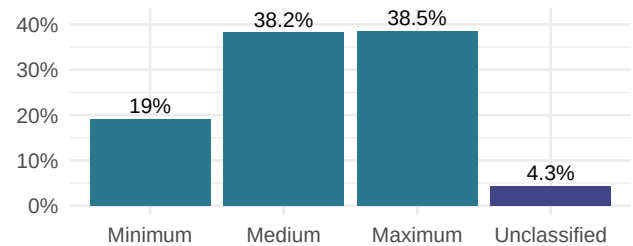
ACJ Population

ACJ population: 1,849

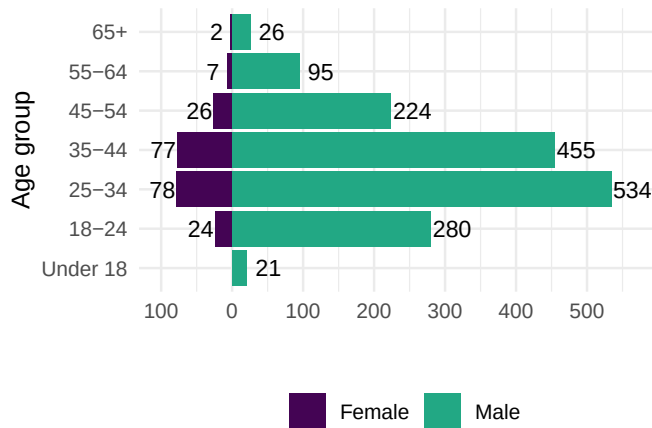


The classification, race and age and gender charts reflect the point-in-time jail population as of **June 30** when it comprised **1,828 adults** and **21 juveniles** of whom **1,635 were men** and **214 were women**. The median length-of-stay for those in the jail was **98 days**. Those labeled unclassified are new arrestees who were in the jail for fewer than 72 hours as of **June 30**.

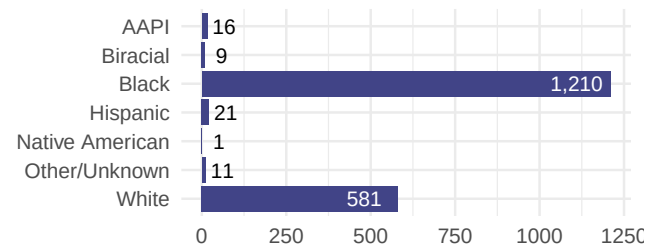
Census by classification level



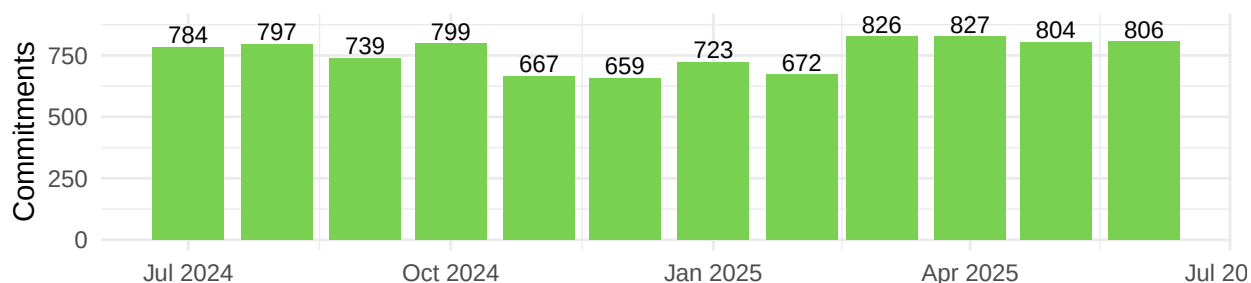
Jail population by age and gender

New commitments to the jail by month

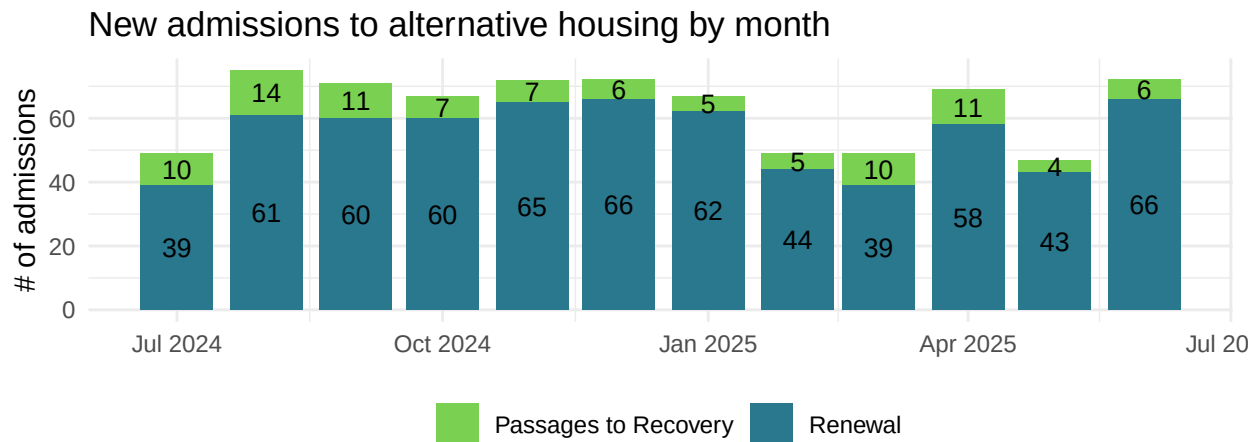
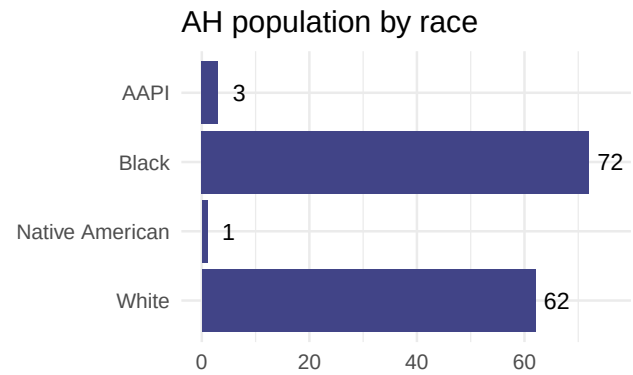
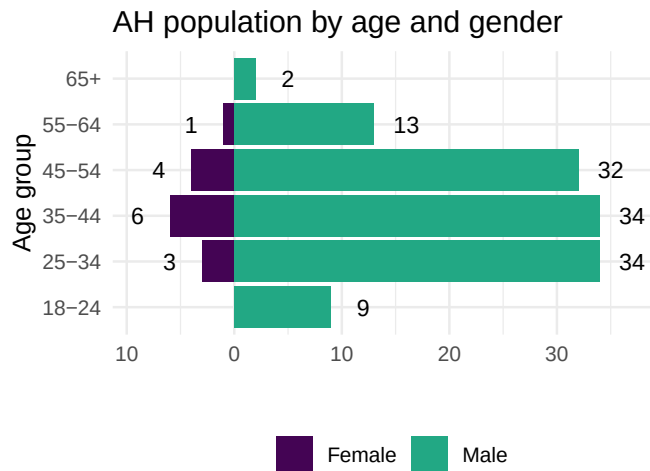




Alternative Housing

Alternative housing population: 138

The alternative housing population as of **June 30** comprised **117 people at Renewal** and **21 people at Passages to Recovery**, of whom **124 were men** and **14 were women**.



Drug and Alcohol Diversion

Released to diversion: 19

In June 2025, **35 people approved for release** for release to outside drug and alcohol diversion programs and **19 people were released** to those programs. As of June 30, there were **17 people in the jail awaiting release** to a program.

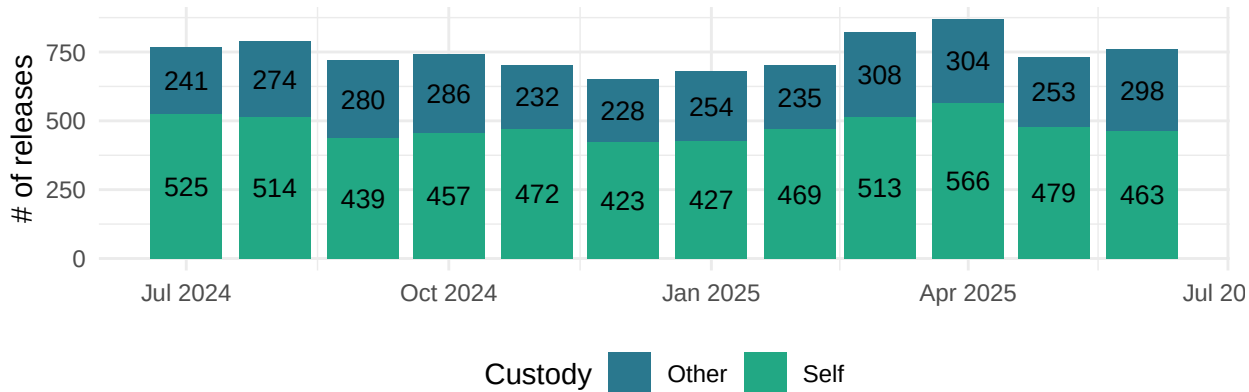

Average release time: 21.5 hours

The average release time concerns people released into their own custody who went through the Discharge and Release Center process. The time to release calculation begins when a clerk initiates the DRC workflow and ends when the person is released from the jail.

In June 2025, there were **761 releases from the jail** — **463** of which involved **people released into their own custody** (other types include releases to rehabilitation programs or other law enforcement agencies). There were 63 cases during June in which there was not a DRC workflow initiated between the person's commitment date and release date. This may happen if someone is released from alternative housing or under pre-trial electronic monitoring. All such cases have been excluded from this analysis.

June releases by custody

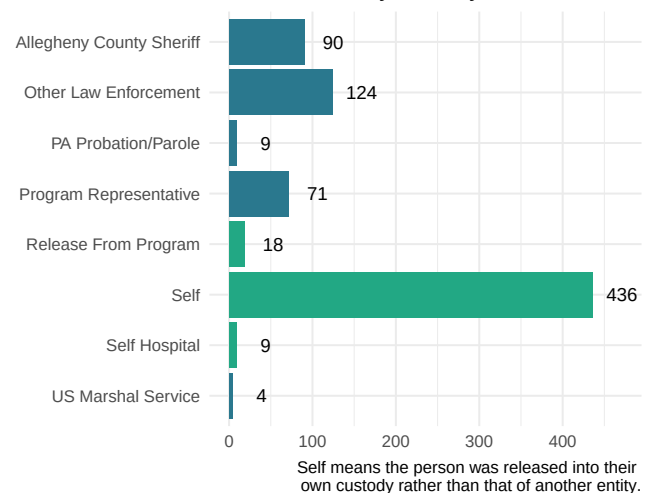

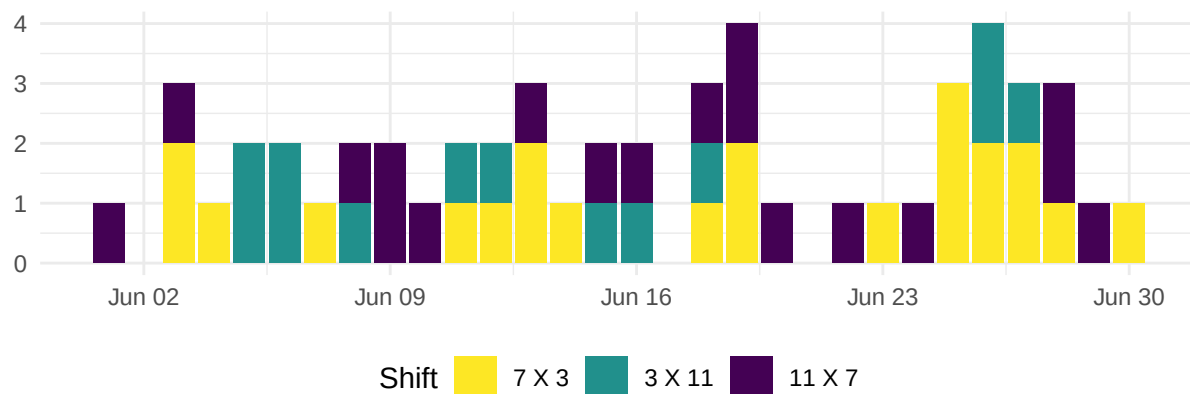
There were **0 suspected overdoses** in the jail in June.

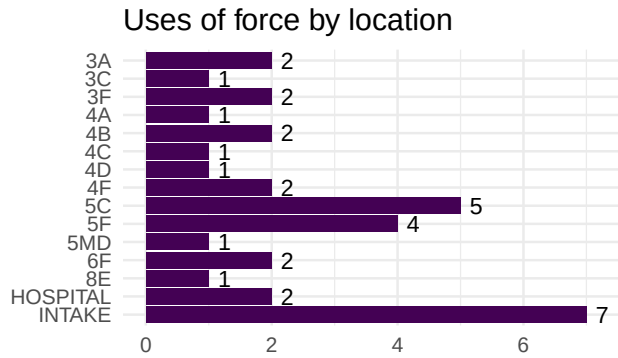

Uses of force occasionally take place across more than one location. When that happens, the sum of location totals will exceed the total number of uses of force.

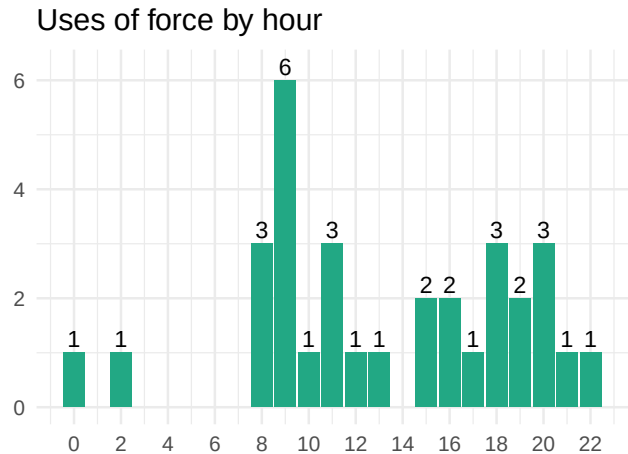

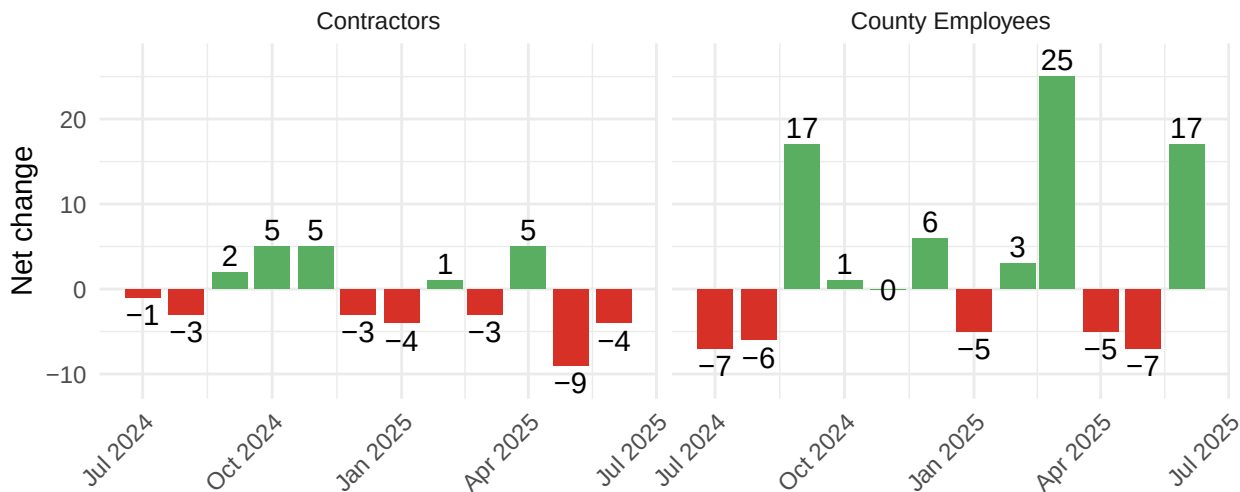

Overtime shifts: 2,400

Correctional officers filled **2,232 overtime shifts** in June 2025, including **1,640 voluntary overtime shifts** and **592 forced overtime shifts**. Sergeants filled **168 overtime shifts**, including **103 voluntary overtime shifts** and **65 forced overtime shifts**. There were **1,886 occasions on which a correctional officer refused** to work an overtime shift.
