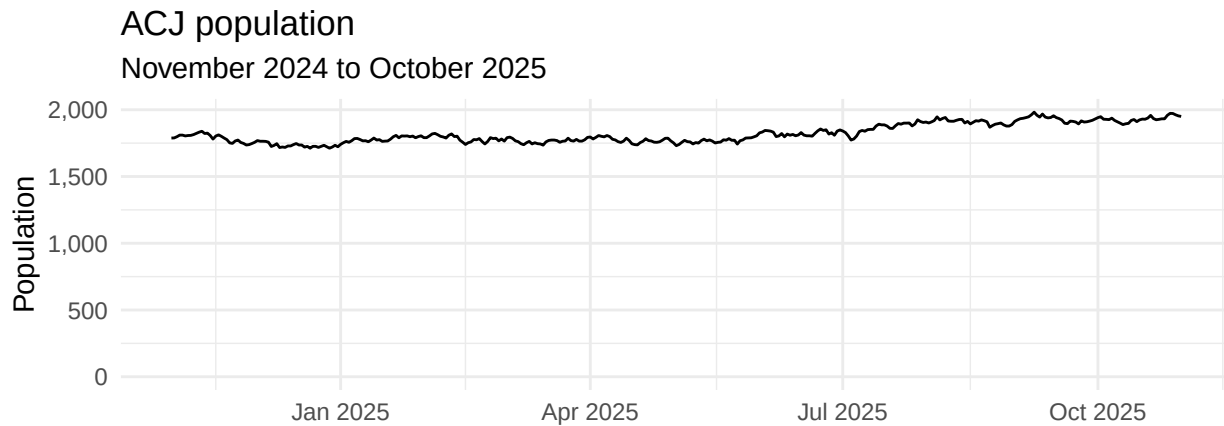
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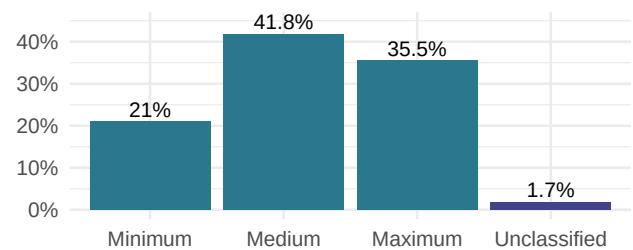
ACJ Population

ACJ population: 1,950

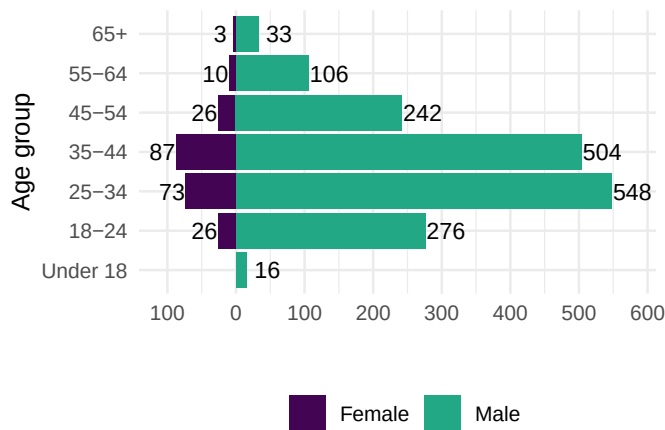


The classification, race and age and gender charts reflect the point-in-time jail population as of **October 31** when it comprised **1,934 adults** and **16 juveniles** of whom **1,725 were men** and **225 were women**. The median length-of-stay for those in the jail was **103 days**. Those labeled unclassified are new arrestees who were in the jail for fewer than 72 hours as of **October 31**.

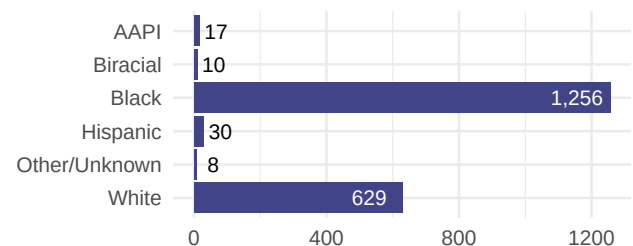
Census by classification level



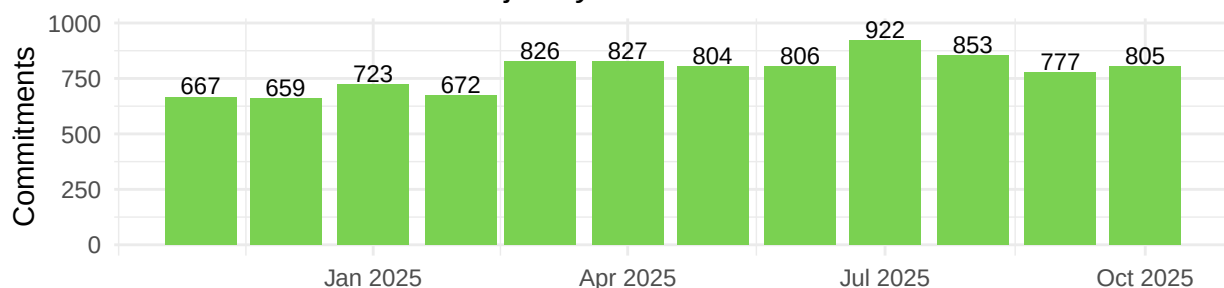
Jail population by age and gender

New commitments to the jail by month

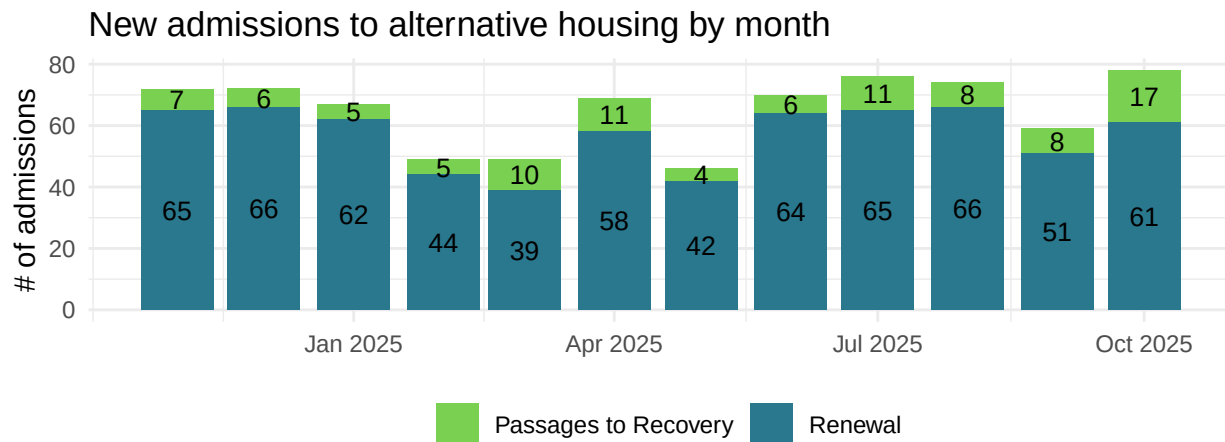
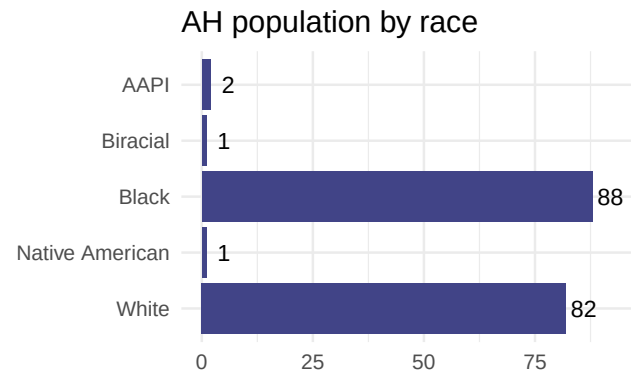
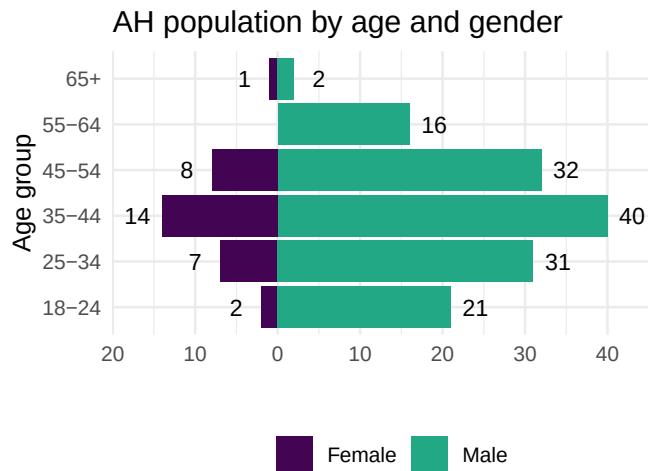




Alternative Housing

Alternative housing population: 174

The alternative housing population as of **October 31** comprised **139 people at Renewal** and **35 people at Passages to Recovery**, of whom **142 were men** and **32 were women**.



Drug and Alcohol Diversion

Released to diversion: 13

In October 2025, **27 people approved for release** for release to outside drug and alcohol diversion programs and **13 people were released** to those programs. As of October 31, there were **17 people in the jail awaiting release** to a program.

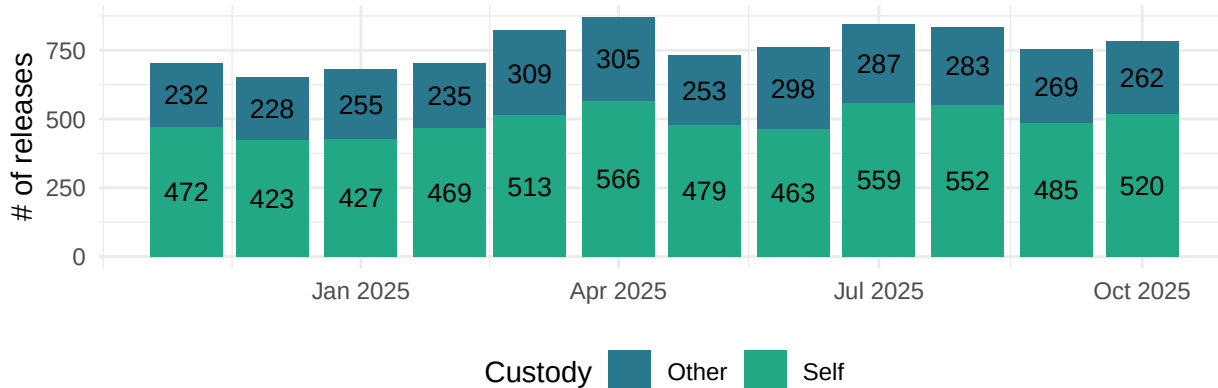

Average release time: 25.1 hours

The average release time concerns people released into their own custody who went through the Discharge and Release Center process. The time to release calculation begins when a clerk initiates the DRC workflow and ends when the person is released from the jail.

In October 2025, there were **782 releases from the jail** — 520 of which involved **people released into their own custody** (other types include releases to rehabilitation programs or other law enforcement agencies). There were 79 cases during October in which there was not a DRC workflow initiated between the person's commitment date and release date. This may happen if someone is released from alternative housing or under pre-trial electronic monitoring. All such cases have been excluded from this analysis.

October releases by custody

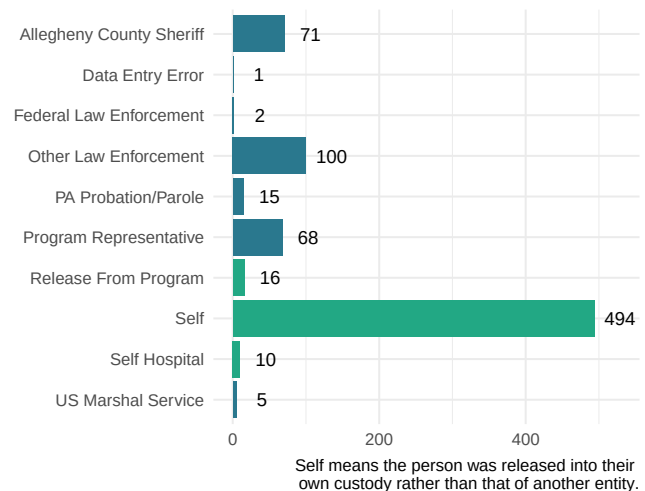

October overdoses by location

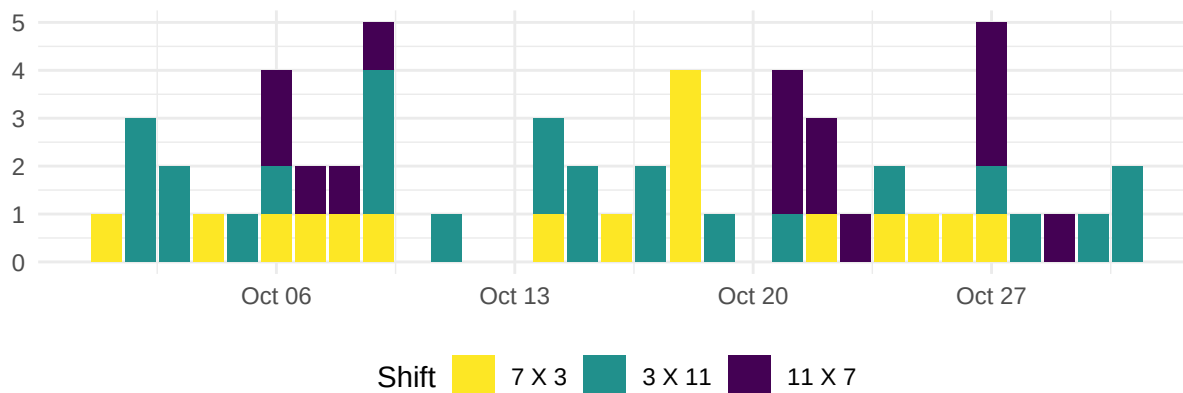


Ambulance Runs

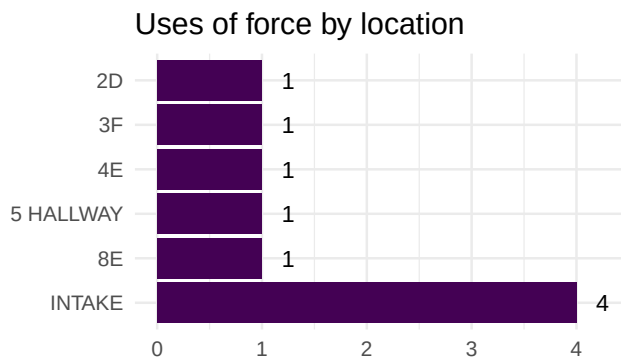

Uses of force occasionally take place across more than one location. When that happens, the sum of location totals will exceed the total number of uses of force.

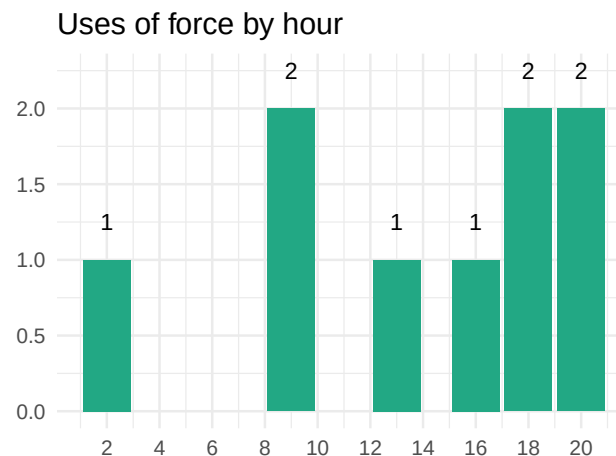

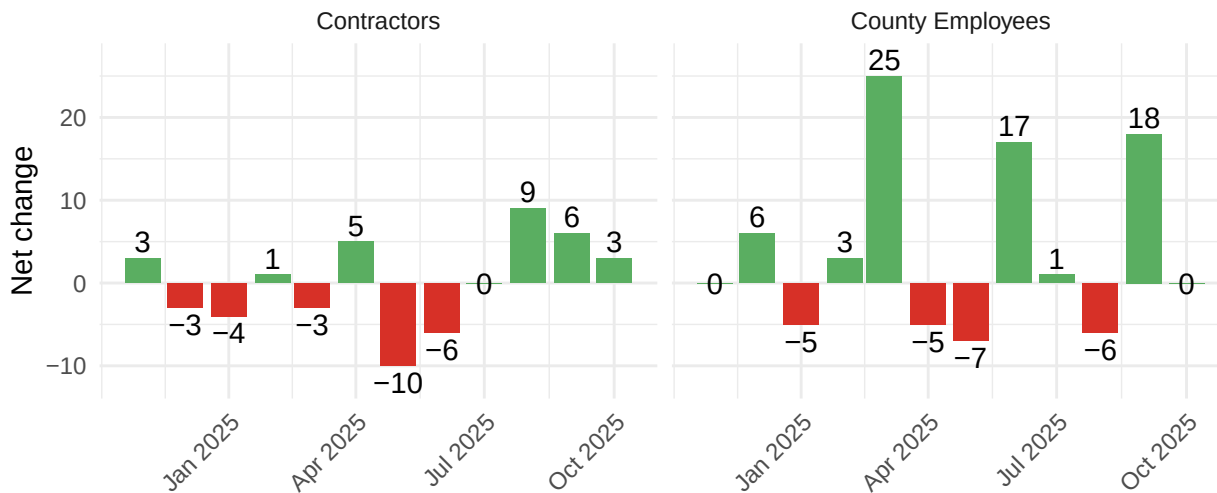

Overtime shifts: 2,567

Correctional officers filled **2,367 overtime shifts** in October 2025, including **1,907 voluntary overtime shifts** and **460 forced overtime shifts**. Sergeants filled **200 overtime shifts**, including **102 voluntary overtime shifts** and **98 forced overtime shifts**. There were **1,849 occasions on which a correctional officer refused** to work an overtime shift.
