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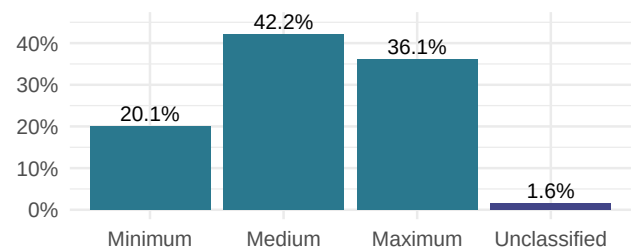
ACJ Population

ACJ population: 1,847

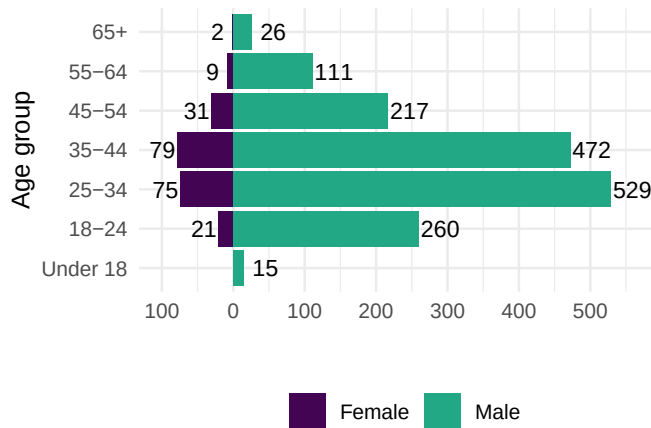


The classification, race and age and gender charts reflect the point-in-time jail population as of **November 30** when it comprised **1,832 adults** and **15 juveniles** of whom **1,630 were men** and **217 were women**. The median length-of-stay for those in the jail was **117 days**. Those labeled unclassified are new arrestees who were in the jail for fewer than 72 hours as of **November 30**.

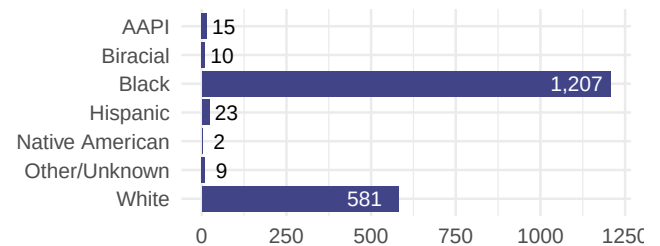
Census by classification level



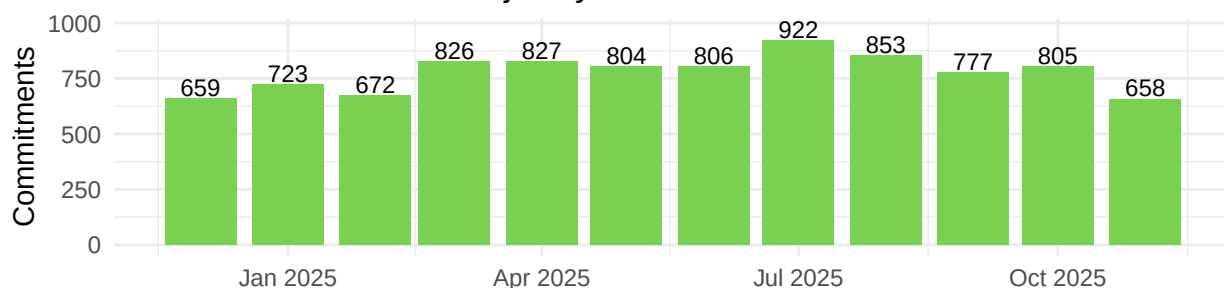
Jail population by age and gender

New commitments to the jail by month

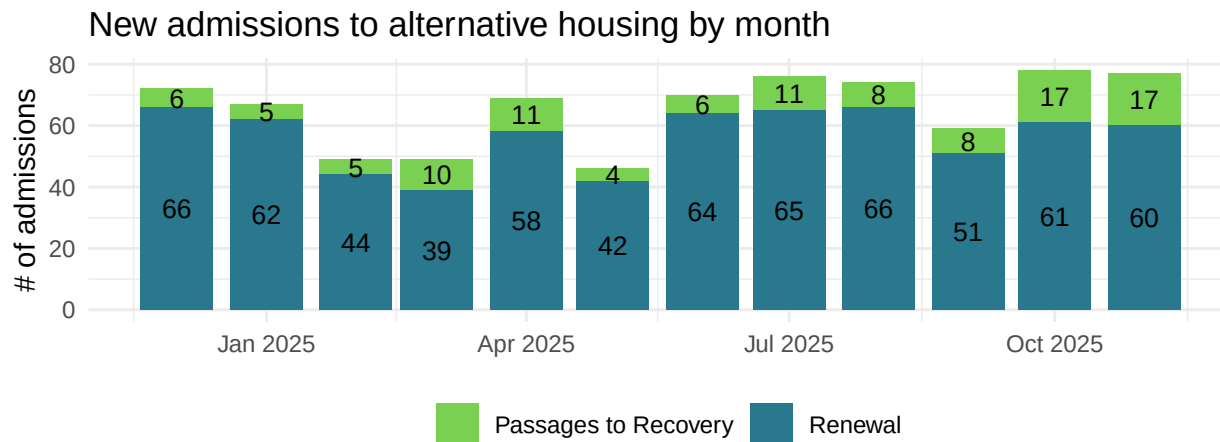
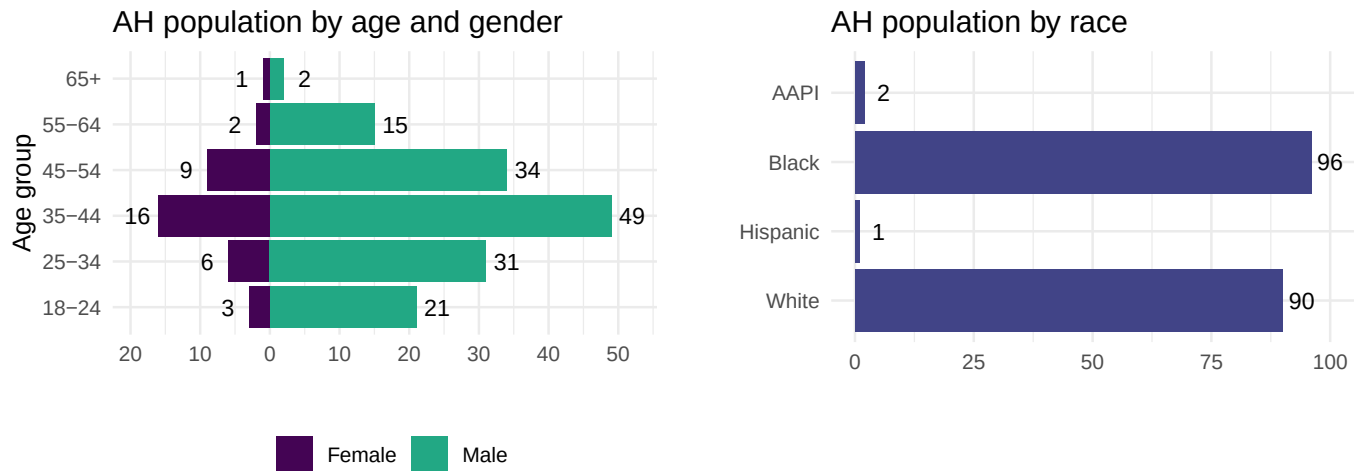




Alternative Housing

Alternative housing population: 189

The alternative housing population as of **November 30** comprised **146 people at Renewal** and **43 people at Passages to Recovery**, of whom **152 were men** and **37 were women**.



Drug and Alcohol Diversion

Released to diversion: 24

In November 2025, **16 people approved for release** for release to outside drug and alcohol diversion programs and **24 people were released** to those programs. As of November 30, there were **4 people in the jail awaiting release** to a program.

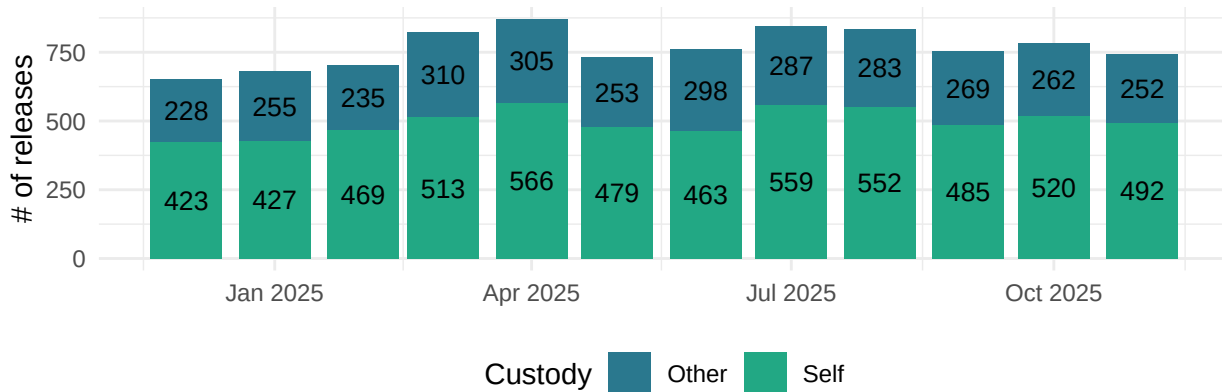

Average release time: 25.4 hours

The average release time concerns people released into their own custody who went through the Discharge and Release Center process. The time to release calculation begins when a clerk initiates the DRC workflow and ends when the person is released from the jail.

In November 2025, there were **744 releases from the jail** — **492** of which involved **people released into their own custody** (other types include releases to rehabilitation programs or other law enforcement agencies). There were 64 cases during November in which there was not a DRC workflow initiated between the person's commitment date and release date. This may happen if someone is released from alternative housing or under pre-trial electronic monitoring. All such cases have been excluded from this analysis.

November releases by custody

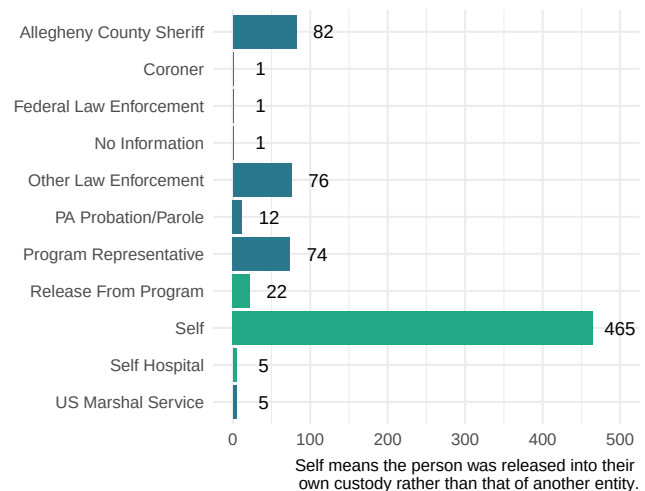

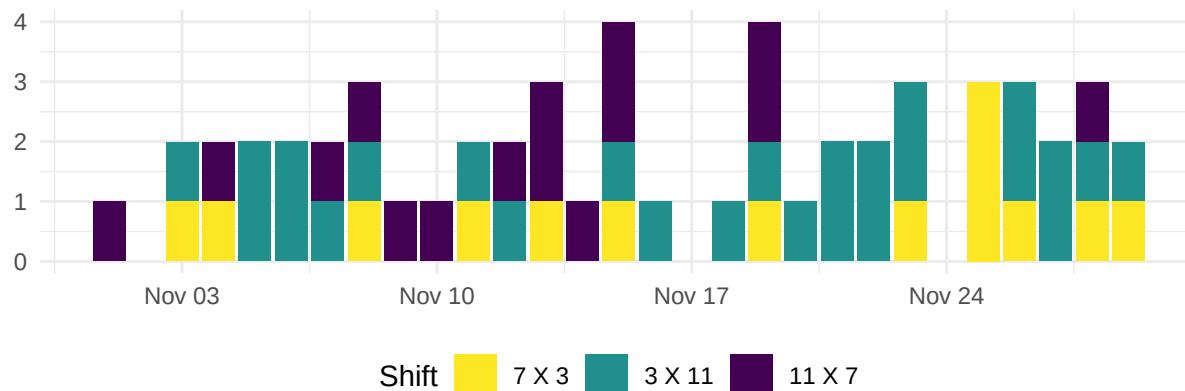


Ambulance Runs

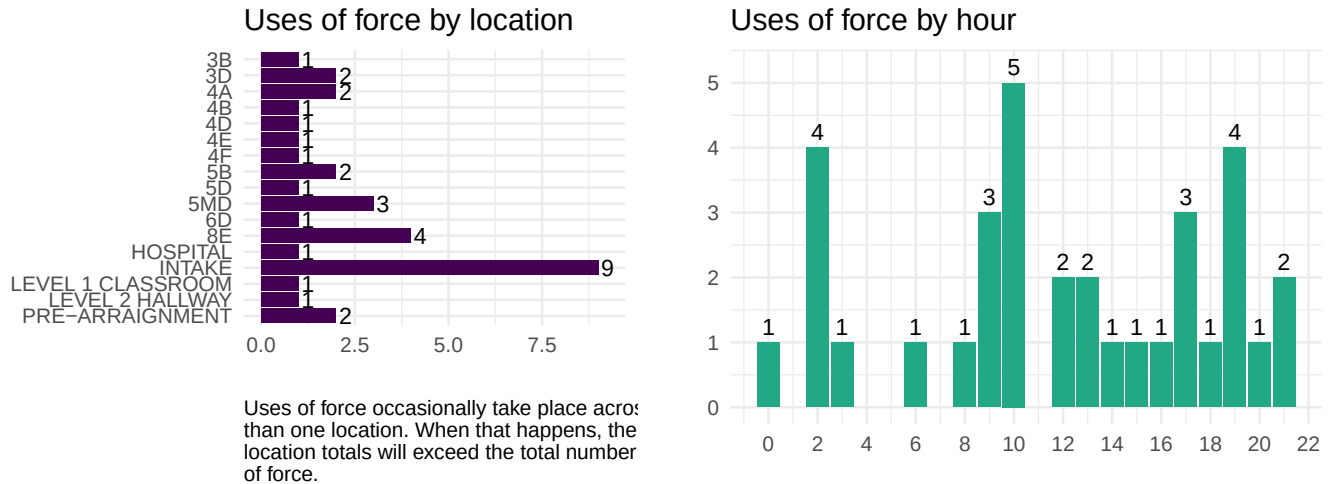

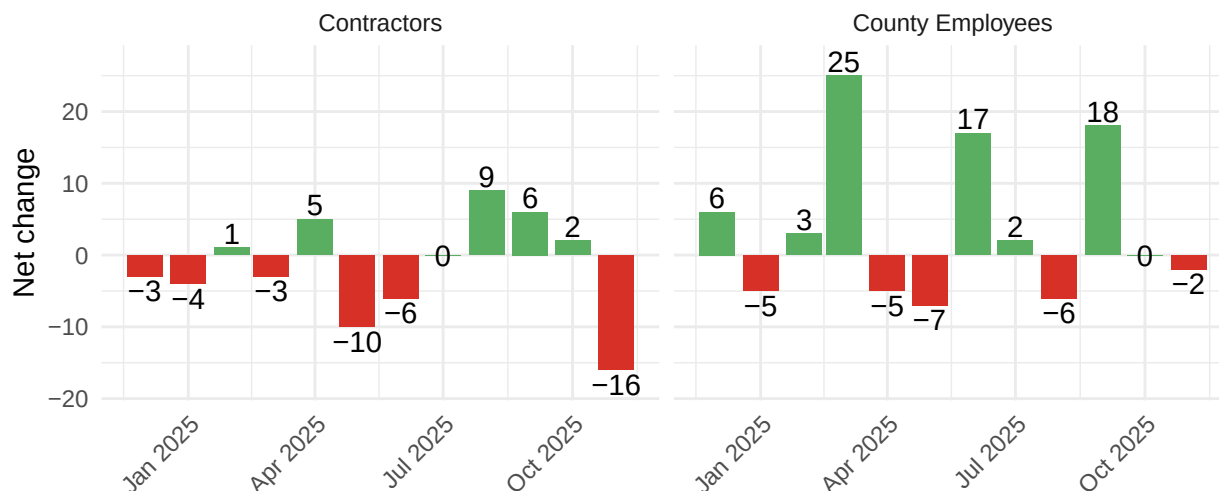

Net change

The number of county employees working at the jail has **increased by 46** over the last 12 months, while the number of contractors has **decreased by 19**.

Overtime shifts: 2,400

Correctional officers filled **2,215 overtime shifts** in November 2025, including **1,798 voluntary overtime shifts** and **417 forced overtime shifts**. Sergeants filled **185 overtime shifts**, including **125 voluntary overtime shifts** and **60 forced overtime shifts**. There were **1,598 occasions on which a correctional officer refused** to work an overtime shift.
