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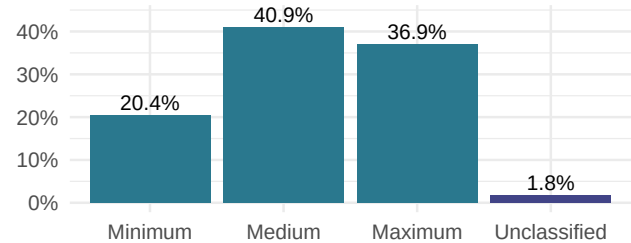
ACJ Population

ACJ population: 1,707

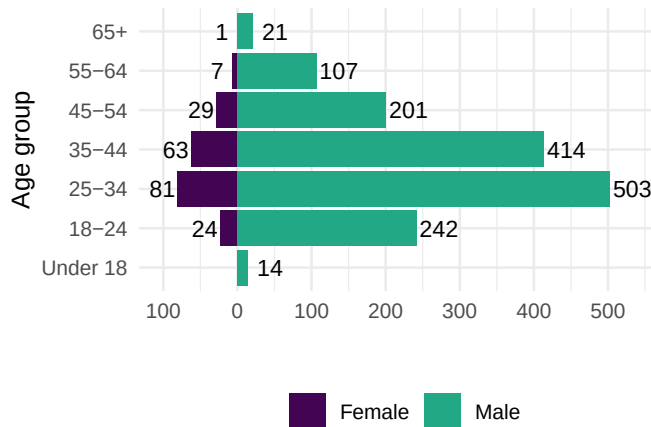


The classification, race and age and gender charts reflect the point-in-time jail population as of **December 31** when it comprised **1,693 adults** and **14 juveniles** of whom **1,502 were men** and **205 were women**. The median length-of-stay for those in the jail was **126 days**. Those labeled unclassified are new arrestees who were in the jail for fewer than 72 hours as of **December 31**.

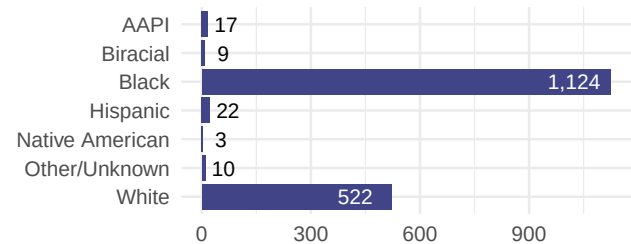
Census by classification level



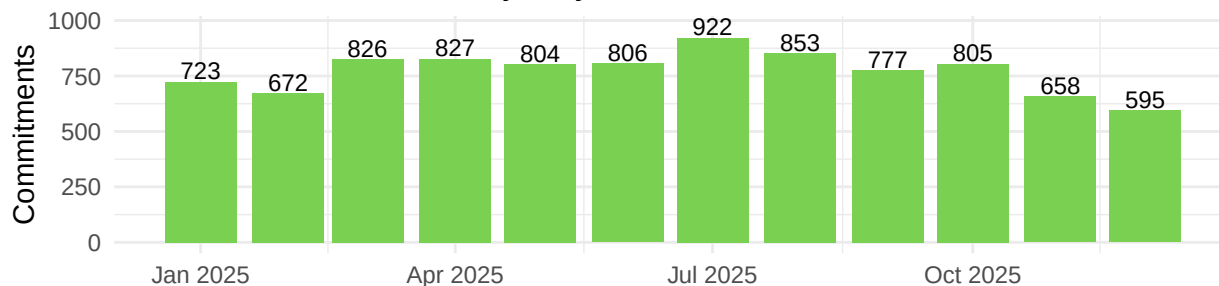
Jail population by age and gender

New commitments to the jail by month

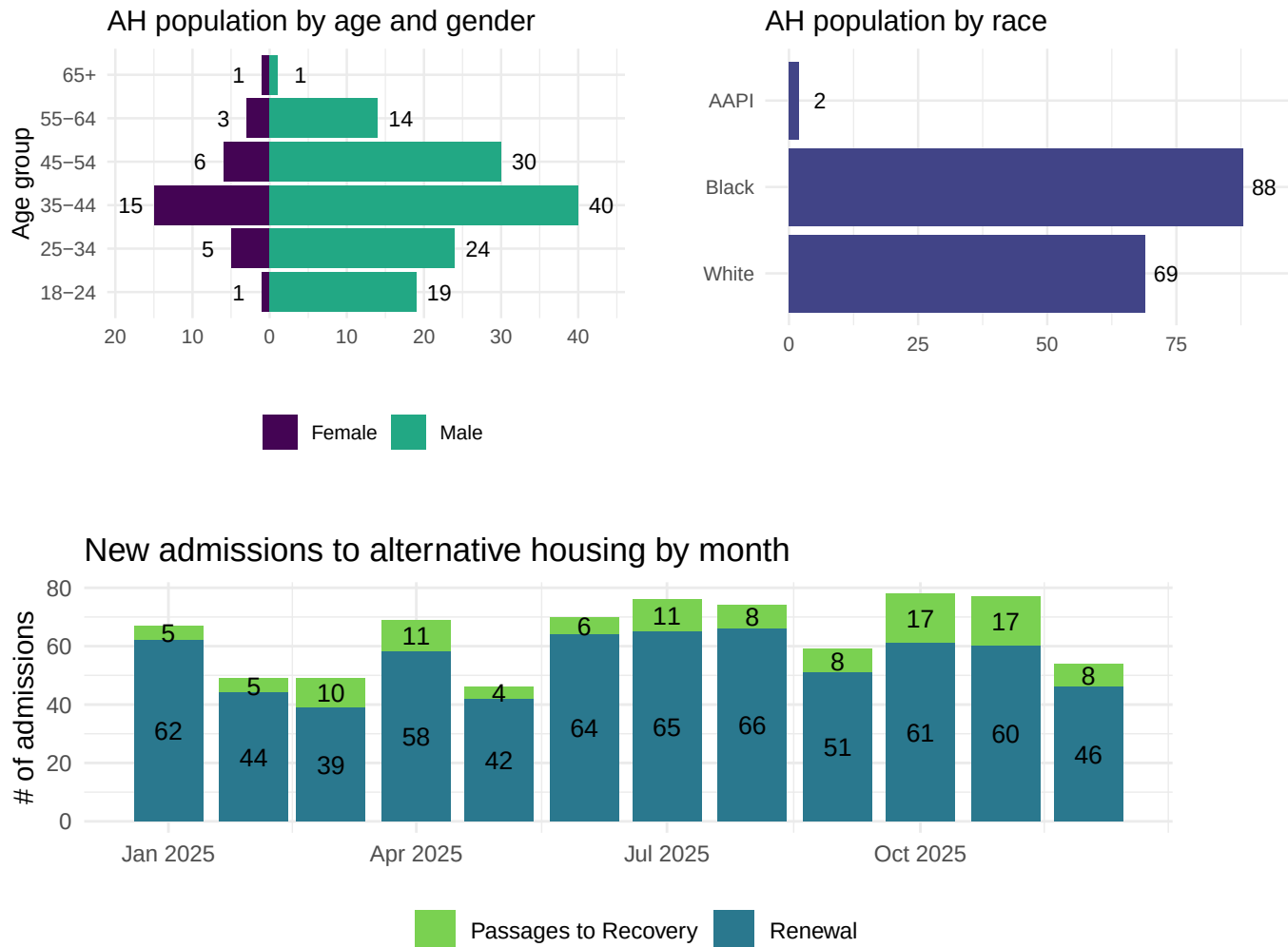




Alternative Housing

Alternative housing population: 159

The alternative housing population as of **December 31** comprised **121 people at Renewal** and **38 people at Passages to Recovery**, of whom **128 were men** and **31 were women**.



Drug and Alcohol Diversion

Released to diversion: 10

In December 2025, **13 people approved for release** for release to outside drug and alcohol diversion programs and **10 people were released** to those programs. As of December 31, there were **5 people in the jail awaiting release** to a program.

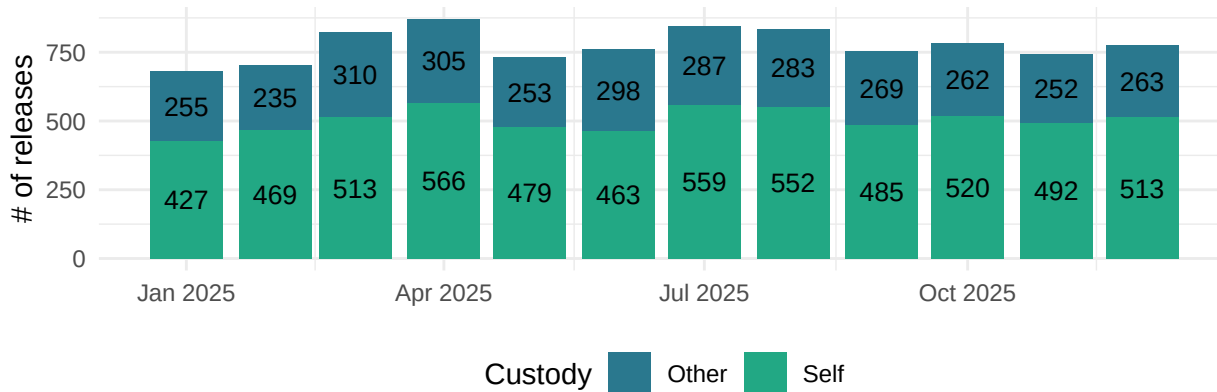

Average release time: 23 hours

The average release time concerns people released into their own custody who went through the Discharge and Release Center process. The time to release calculation begins when a clerk initiates the DRC workflow and ends when the person is released from the jail.

In December 2025, there were **776 releases from the jail** — **513** of which involved **people released into their own custody** (other types include releases to rehabilitation programs or other law enforcement agencies). There were 89 cases during December in which there was not a DRC workflow initiated between the person's commitment date and release date. This may happen if someone is released from alternative housing or under pre-trial electronic monitoring. All such cases have been excluded from this analysis.

December releases by custody

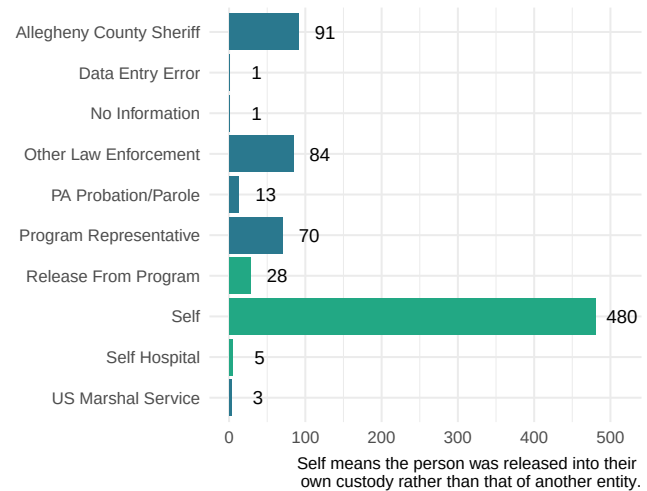

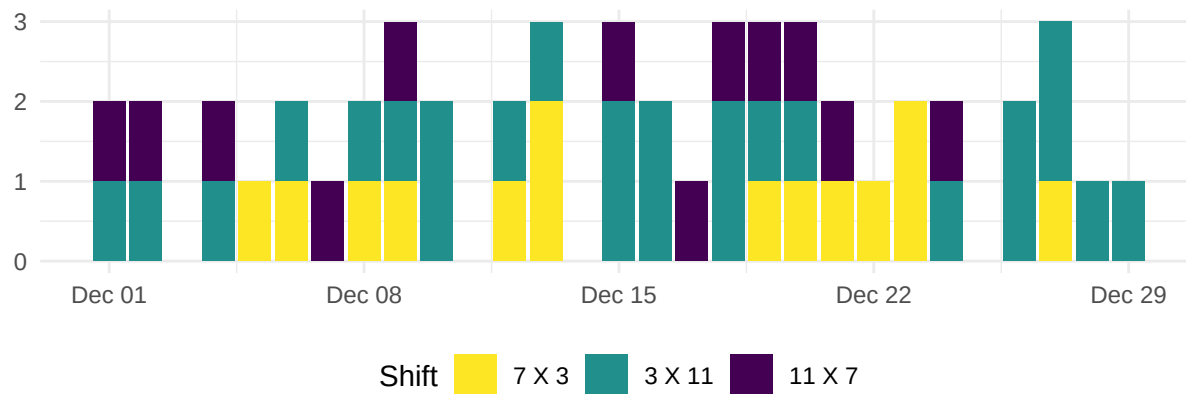
There were **0 suspected overdoses** in the jail in December.

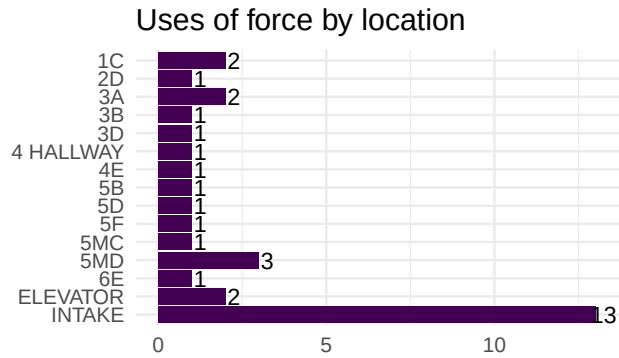

Uses of force occasionally take place across more than one location. When that happens, the sum of location totals will exceed the total number of uses of force.

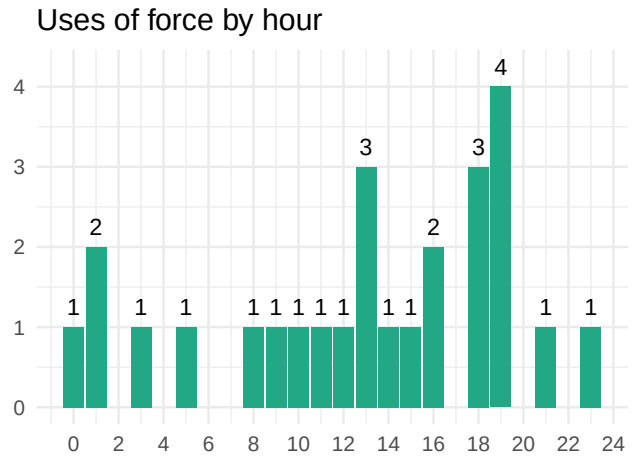

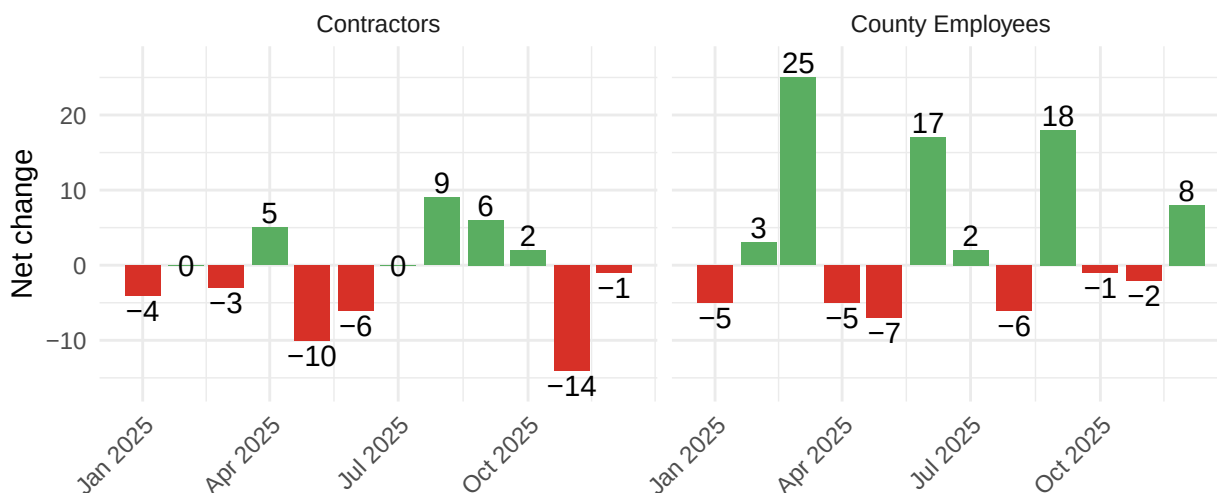

Overtime shifts: 2,296

Correctional officers filled **2,107 overtime shifts** in December 2025, including **1,708 voluntary overtime shifts** and **399 forced overtime shifts**. Sergeants filled **189 overtime shifts**, including **114 voluntary overtime shifts** and **75 forced overtime shifts**. There were **1,631 occasions on which a correctional officer refused** to work an overtime shift.
