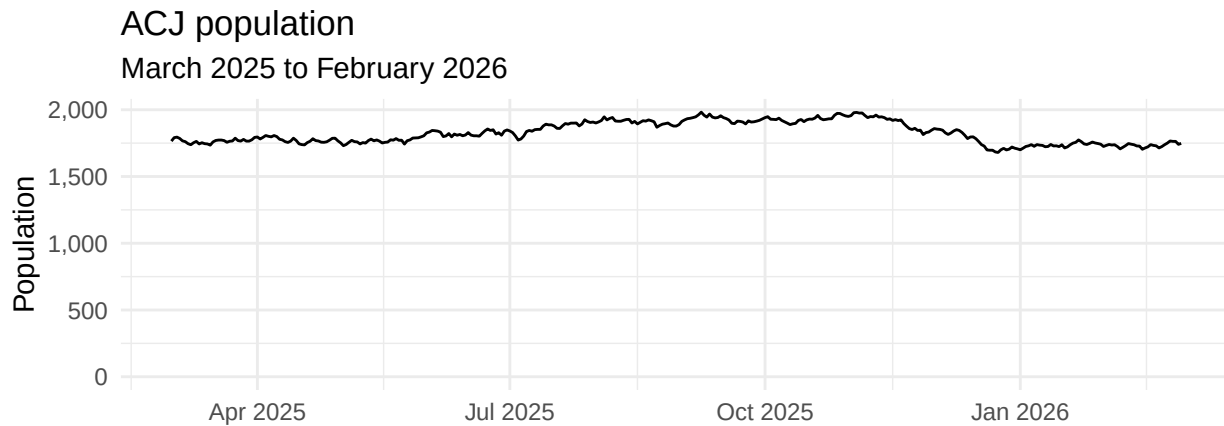

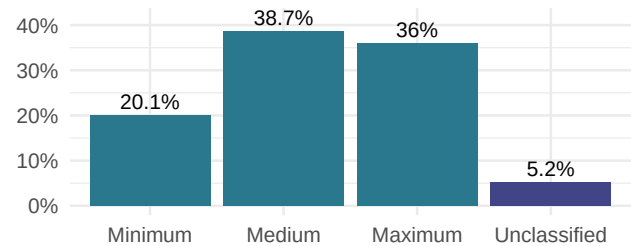
ACJ Population

ACJ population: 1,748

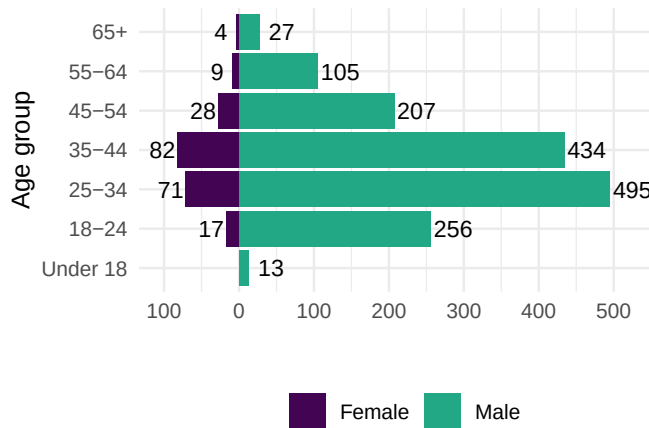


The classification, race and age and gender charts reflect the point-in-time jail population as of **February 28** when it comprised **1,735 adults** and **13 juveniles** of whom **1,537 were men** and **211 were women**. The median length-of-stay for those in the jail was **123.5 days**. Those labeled unclassified are new arrestees who were in the jail for fewer than 72 hours as of **February 28**.

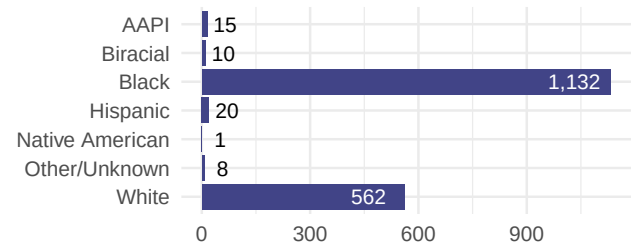
Census by classification level



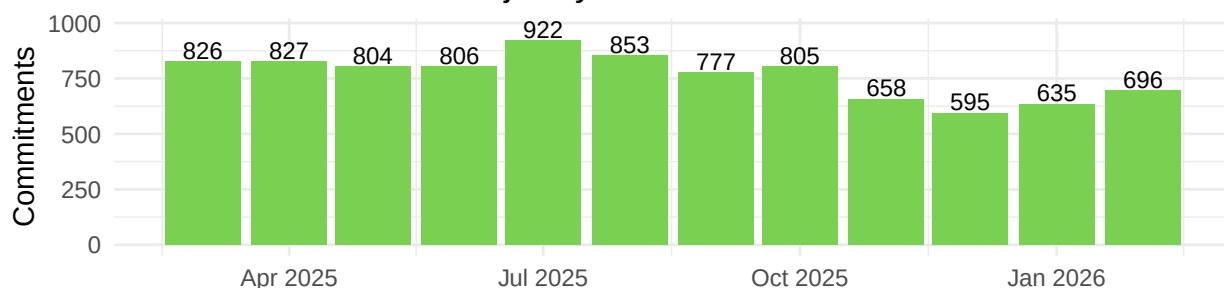
Jail population by age and gender

New commitments to the jail by month

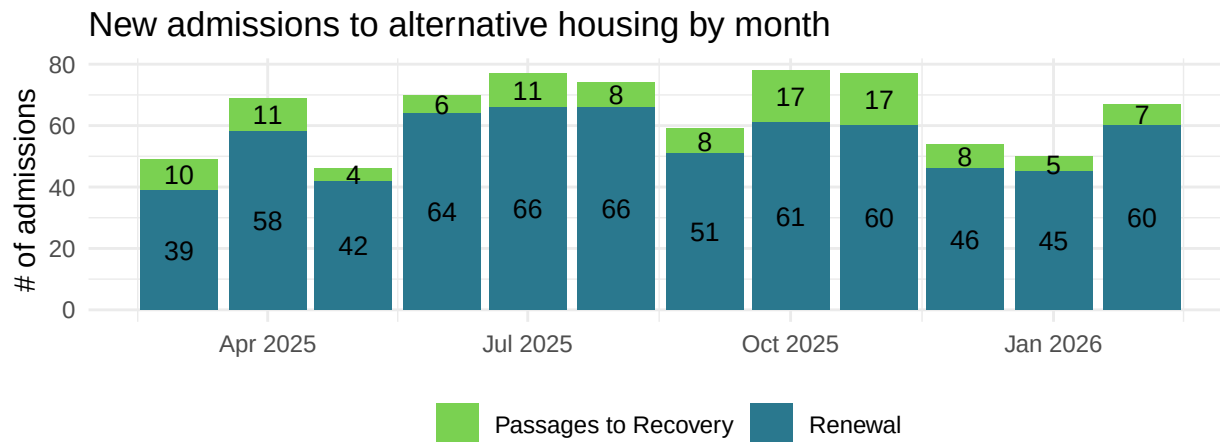
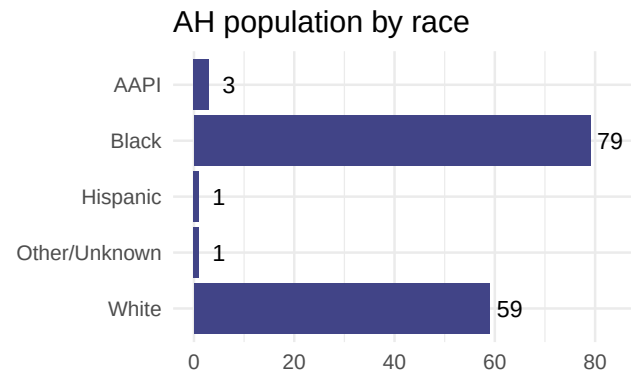
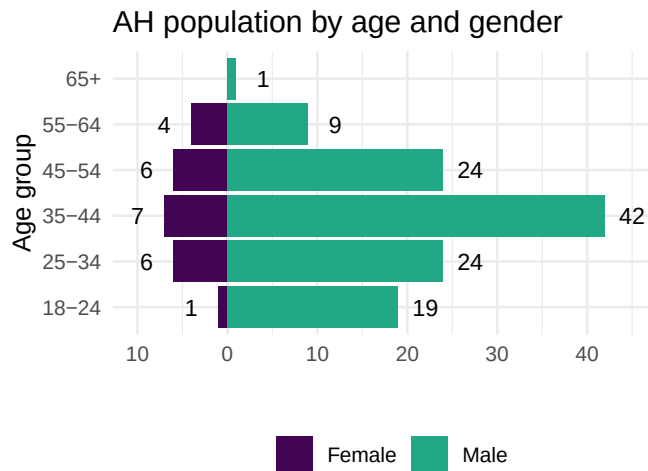




Alternative Housing

Alternative housing population: 143

The alternative housing population as of **February 28** comprised **124 people at Renewal** and **19 people at Passages to Recovery**, of whom **119 were men** and **24 were women**.



Drug and Alcohol Diversion

Released to diversion: 19

In February 2026, **23 people approved for release** for release to outside drug and alcohol diversion programs and **19 people were released** to those programs. As of February 28, there were **12 people in the jail awaiting release** to a program.

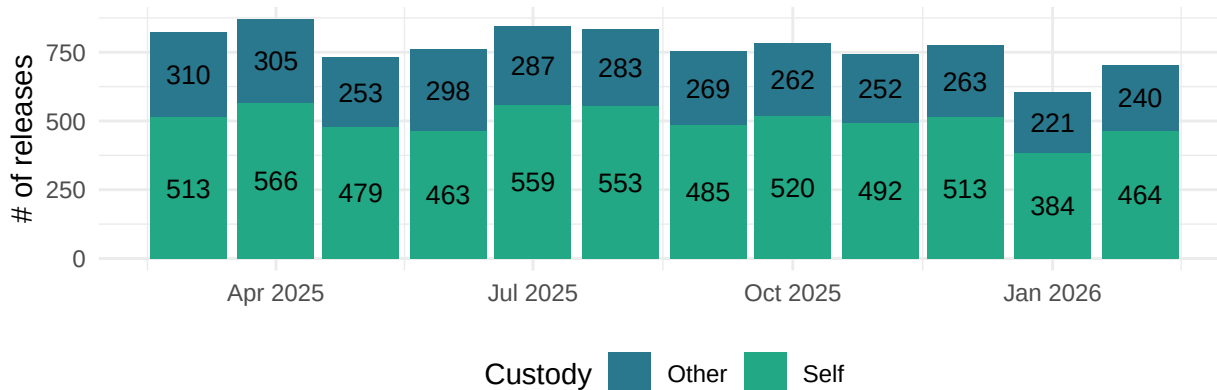

Total releases: 704

Average release time: 22.5 hours

The average release time concerns people released into their own custody who went through the Discharge and Release Center process. The time to release calculation begins when a clerk initiates the DRC workflow and ends when the person is released from the jail.

In February 2026, there were **704 releases from the jail** — **464** of which involved **people released into their own custody** (other types include releases to rehabilitation programs or other law enforcement agencies). There were 118 cases during February in which there was not a DRC workflow initiated between the person's commitment date and release date. This may happen if someone is released from alternative housing or under pre-trial electronic monitoring. All such cases have been excluded from this analysis.

February releases by custody

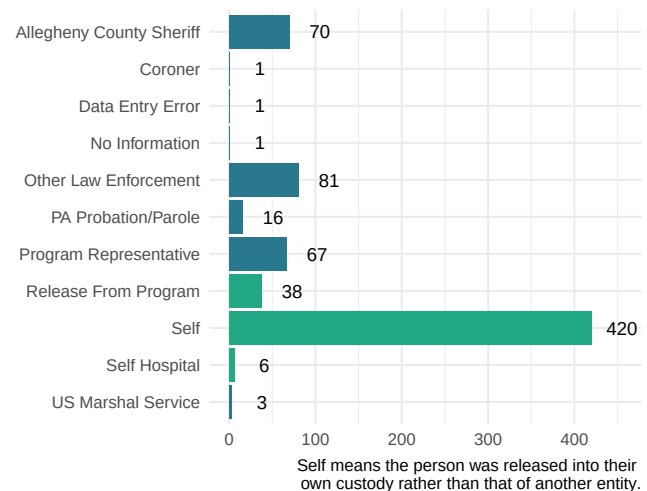

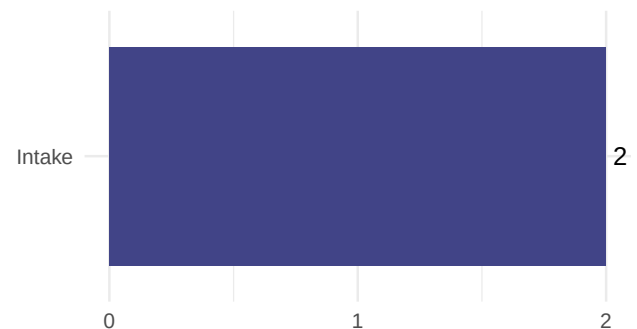

February overdoses by location

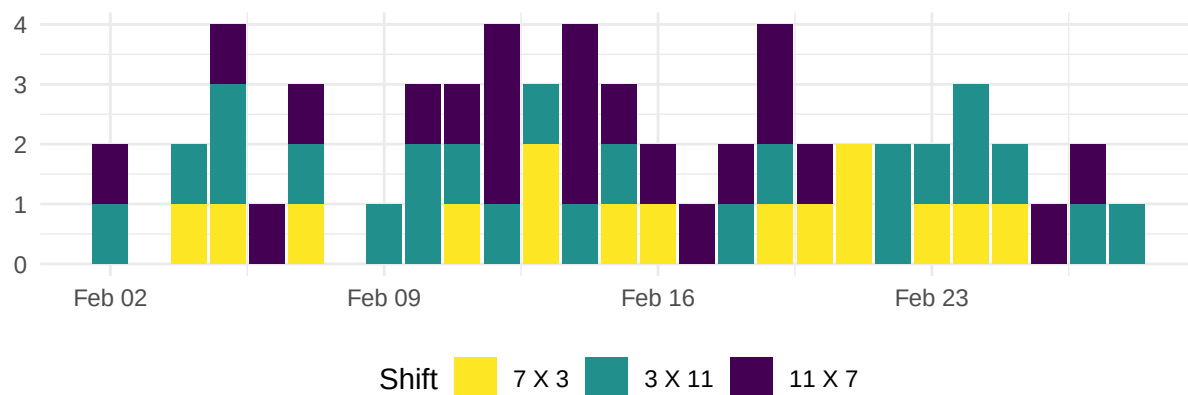


Ambulance Runs

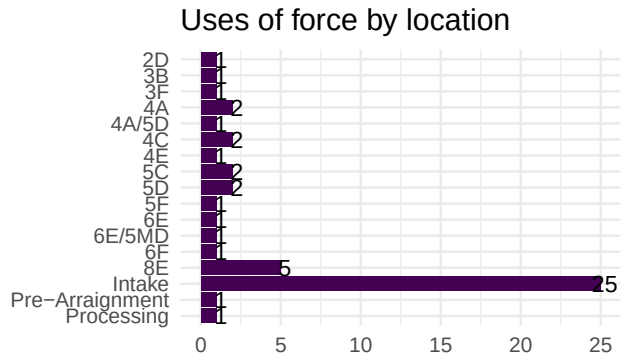

Uses of force occasionally take place across more than one location. When that happens, the sum of location totals will exceed the total number of uses of force.

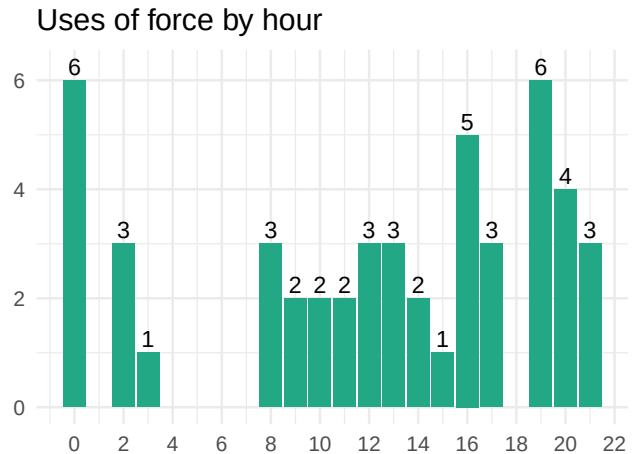

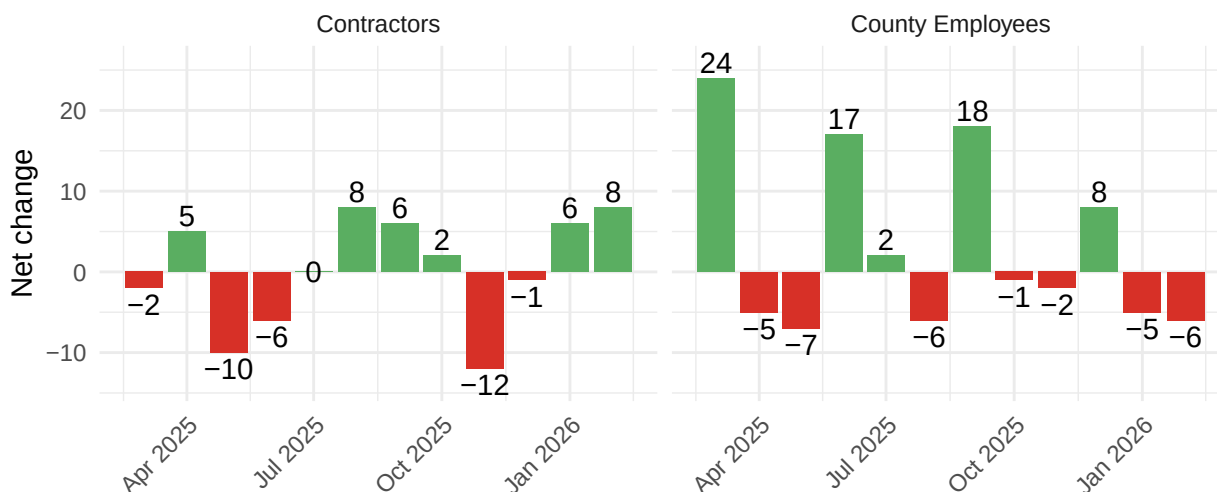

Overtime shifts: 2,200

Correctional officers filled **2,047 overtime shifts** in February 2026, including **1,596 voluntary overtime shifts** and **451 forced overtime shifts**. Sergeants filled **153 overtime shifts**, including **115 voluntary overtime shifts** and **38 forced overtime shifts**. There were **2,407 occasions on which a correctional officer refused** to work an overtime shift.
